



CAPITAL CITY FUTURITY - EVENT GUIDELINES

Contestants - It is your responsibility to read, understand and abide by event rules and guidelines. Our rules and guidelines are in place to assure a smooth running event for all to enjoy.

- NBHA Rules Apply – www.nbha.com
- Dress Code – Jeans or appropriate long pants, boots (must have a boot heel), long sleeve shirt/pullover (sleeves rolled down, collar optional). Hats/Helmets optional, NO BALL CAPS/VISORS!
- All fees must be paid PRIOR to making your run.
- Mail In Entries Postmarked by October 8th, Online Entries completed by October 15th. Online entries must be paid by PayPal before you will be added to draw. No refunds after draw is posted.
- We reserve the right to change the onsite late entry period at our discretion should a change be necessary due to the total number of show pre-entries.
- Pre-Entry draw will be posted online by 7:00 p.m., Thursday, October 21st - www.nbhaks09.com
- Pre-Entry spots may be sold. Horse/Rider changes MUST be completed in the show office BEFORE the 1st horse runs in the class (NO EXCEPTIONS!) Spots cannot be sold after the class has started for any reason!
- We will drag every 5 runners (regardless of scratches) and have a big drag every 50.
- Horses MUST be run in the position drawn. Failure to do so will result in a disqualification. Running out of turn in a manner that affects the other contestants in a drag will result in disqualification.
- Any changes or corrections to the draw after online posting will be posted at show office and noted on the official's sheet. It is your responsibility as a contestant to know the position of the horses drawn.
- You MUST CHECK IN with the gate official and be IN the holding pen/area (as defined by the gate official) when your drag is called for. It is your responsibility to check in with the gate official and be prepared to run in your drawn position. Every effort will be made to give each contestant fair and ample time to enter the arena at the gate crew's discretion. We do reserve the right to scratch a contestant for failing to enter the arena to compete after 3 gate calls.
- Contestants will receive a no time for knocking over a barrel or breaking the pattern. Contestants who are given a no-time for going off pattern or for a downed barrel may complete the pattern, but under NO CIRCUMSTANCES are they allowed to circle a barrel twice. At the discretion of show management, a rider may be asked to leave the arena immediately if they are taking excessive time to train.
- All reruns will be the decisions of the Arena Director. In the case of a timer malfunction rider will be offered a re-run.
- Rerun will be made on a fresh drag at the end of the class. For timer malfunctions after the timer starts, PRIOR PENALTIES WILL APPLY. If rider chooses to run again any penalties made during re-run WILL apply to official time. Arena Director's decisions are FINAL.
- Only one horse may be in the arena at any time during the competition.
- The Futurity is open to 4 or 5 year old horses. The horse shall not have competed in a barrel race before November 15th of the previous year. The age of unregistered horses will be determined by a veterinarian. The Futurity is based on 2 go's and an average. Total Times of the 2 rounds will determine the average winners. Futurity results are based on 1 sec split. A copy of registration papers must be turned into the office before competition. Payout as follows 40% of the entry fee goes into the pot for 1st and 2nd Go's, 20% to the average pot. Added money \$1300 added to each go with \$400 to the average for a total of \$3000 added
- Derby Horses must be 7 and under. Horses can run 1 year in the futurity and 2 consecutive years in the Derby. The Derby is 2 separate runs. No Average. Results are based on 1 sec splits. Futurity and Derby are 2D races, one second splits. Payout each day with average awards for the weekend. No average payout.
- Open is 5D payout on ½ second splits. Payout each day.

- Side Pots
 - \$20 - \$100 Added PURINA SIDE POT (receipt from local feed store required)
 - Amateur Futurity Rider Rules
 - Amateur Riders are based on these qualifications. Within the previous 3 years-
 1. Must not train barrel horses for compensation.
 2. You or an immediate family member must own the horse you are entering.
 3. Held membership in accreditation with the PRCA, WPRA or IPRA in barrel racing.
- Youth entries are defined as 18 & under as of January 1st - Payout on 4D Format (1 sec. splits)
- Senior entries are defined as 50 & older as of October 23rd – Payout on 4D Format (1 sec. splits)
- Carry over times MUST be declared to the show office prior to the start of the classes for the day for any pre-entered contestants.
- Late entries must declare carry over at the time of entry.
- Daily buckles Saturday and Sunday to Futurity, Derby, Open, Senior and Youth Division winners!! Average awards to 5th place in the Futurity!!!
- Sanctions - BBR, NBHA BRF & WPRA, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to verify with the show office that we have your information on file.
- Payout Guidelines will be per NBHA Rules
 - 75% payback jackpot of entry fee, 100% advertised added money will be paid back
 - In the event that “D” does not fill, we reserve the right to make adjustments to the payouts to allow fair and adequate disbursements of the jackpot.
- Races that are advertised as Run For the Bonus Qualifying events we will take out \$1 per run that will go towards the BONUS RACE FINALS
